

Bonnie and Clyde Information Sheet

1. What is the show about?

Bonnie and Clyde is about the famous bankrobbing couple that terrorized the upper Midwest and Southern United States during the 1930s. Desperate to be famous, these two definitely pick an interesting way to go about achieving their goal. Still, the musical, much like the classic 1960s movie, tries to do more than simply telling the story as two criminals.

2. What is cast size?

The cast size will be somewhere around 15.

3. When will rehearsals be?

Rehearsals will start in June. Those rehearsals will typically be a mix of vocal rehearsals and blocking. The goal in June-Mid July is to have the majority of the cast be present no more than three days a week. Leads may need to be present four days a week in some cases. Once we get to the last two weeks of the show, rehearsals may increase in number, but typically, there will always be at least one day off during the normal work week. Rehearsals usually run 2-3 hours.

4. What will auditions be like?

You can choose to sing up to 32 bars of a song of your choice or we will have something available you can sing at auditions. The style of the music tends more towards rock country with a dash of bluegrass. If you bring your own song, please be prepared with a recorded accompaniment track or acapella. You will then read a small part of the script. These will be provided at the audition.

5. What do I need to bring to auditions?

The critical thing to bring is your completed audition application. This includes the conflict calendars for June, July, and Early August.

6. When are performances?

We will either have three or four performance during the first weekend in August.
